Specific Duties

- Regular Attendance - Uniform is not required, but encouraged
 - Attend as many Tuesday night meetings as possible
 - Attend as many monthly camping trips as possible; Spring New Scout camp out (typically April) is a required camping trip for this position
 - Attend as many extra events as possible
- Understand role for next meeting
 - Work with Scoutmaster(s) and/or other ASM to verify role
 - Work with Scout leadership to assist young Scouts earn rank advancement
 - Know requirements for each of the first four ranks (Scout, Tenderfoot, 2nd Class & 1st Class) and how to teach them
- Encourage
 - Work with Scouts as needed
 - Encourage and promote Scout values
